In our Drawing Room, Mission Room, or Ballroom, Loughed House can accommodate from 10 to 96 guests for a sit down dinner, or up to 120 guests for a cocktail-style reception and dance.



DRAWING ROOM

The Drawing Room was originally used by the Loughed family to receive many renowned guests, including royalty and stars of the stage and screen. Your guests will delight in the splendor of this room as they share in your customized, catered dinner. The room can seat up to eight tables of eight people. It will also double as your ceremony room in the event of inclement weather.



MISSION ROOM

The Mission Room makes a stunning venue for dinner or a small, intimate wedding ceremony. With all round three-quarter length windows, guests can enjoy views of the breathtaking Gardens. The Mission Room accommodates four round tables, each seating eight guests.


